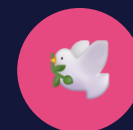

The Lord Will Provide. Provision shows up right on time — not early, not late.

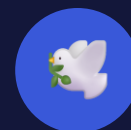

RESPONSE TIME

"Father, I trade my anxiety for trust in Your sufficiency. Thank You that You'll provide exactly what I need, exactly when I need it..."

WEEK 3

Healer · Peace · Victory

OPENING HOOK

Anxiety before the exam. The friendship that still stings. The battle nobody knows about. God's names meet you exactly there.

The Lord Who Heals. Deeper than a surface fix — body, mind, and heart.

The Lord Is My Banner. Victory isn't self-made — it's whose flag you stand under.

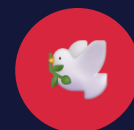

Ever-Present · All-Seeing · Father

OPENING HOOK

Not a title you memorize — a relationship you run to.

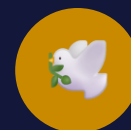
